2018 Global E3 Annual Meeting Hong Kong Polytechnic University April 5-7, 2018

The Institute of International Education (IIE) and Hong Kong Polytechnic University invite proposals for workshops and sessions addressing timely topics during the 2018 Global E3 Annual Meeting.

Session Outlines are due by Friday, December 15, 2017.
Final Proposals are due by January 19, 2018 by email to ge3@iie.org.

The theme of the 2018 Annual Meeting is *Engineering Education for a Sustainable Economy*.

Possible Session/Workshop Topics include (but are not limited to):

- How we can design curricula to meet the rapidly changing economy
- Which is the best pedagogy to prepare future graduates - industry experience, conventional learning, other?
- Preparing Engineering students to address global challenges
- East meets West in exchange
- How to incorporate research into exchange
- Summer research opportunities and other short-term programs – designing, promoting, and engaging students
- Promoting GE3 to students at your university and enhancing the participation rate

A key objective of the Annual Meeting is for representatives from member institutions to network and share best practices that can increase the reach of Global E3. **Session proposals should not be limited to those listed above.** Other topics of general interest that are relevant to the exchange of engineering students and faculty will be given full consideration. Sessions are normally 60-75 minutes long but will vary depending on the topic and number of speakers. Panelists should include a range of perspectives from several countries if possible. Sessions involving small group discussions are also welcomed.

We encourage interested speakers or panel chairs to submit a brief outline of a proposed meeting session (with some but not necessarily all proposed speakers) by December 15, 2017. Proposals will be reviewed by a conference committee with those of the strongest general interest invited to submit full proposals, including a list of confirmed speakers/panelists and any session materials needed, due by January 19, 2018. **Send outlines and final proposals to ge3@iie.org.**
