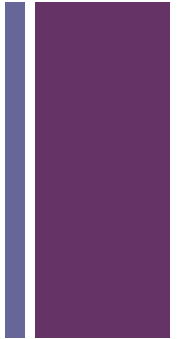

- A comprehensive teaching, research, and service institution dedicated to accessibility and excellence in undergraduate and graduate education
- Founded in 1847, the College is the oldest urban institution of higher education in the country
- Dedicated to the STEM fields, the College offers 13 doctoral programs in Engineering and Science
- Undergraduate student to faculty ratio is 13 to 1
- An enrollment of more than 16,000 students
- One of the most diverse student populations in the United States
- More than 100 languages are spoken on campus, from Spanish and Haitian Creole to critical languages such as Arabic, Hindi, Farsi and Mandarin
- College enrolls a large percentage of first generation Americans (and first generation college students).
- On-campus housing is available for all students



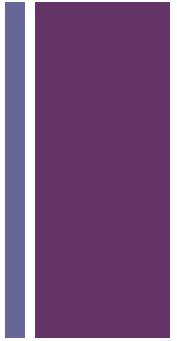
International Education at CCNY: Int'l Student & Scholar Services



- CCNY has been a designated exchange visitor program sponsor since 1954
- The International Student Services (ISS) Office assists students and scholars with a variety of academic and counseling support services
- Staff are trained and consistently follow updated Department of Home Land Security (DHS) regulations
- Staff organizes day-orientation sessions, special social events and trips every semester
- Assists students while adapting to life in the U.S. with items such as obtaining Social Security cards, employment permission, drivers licenses, bank accounts, foreign exchange permits, and military service deferrals
- Professional counseling assistance available for students with immigration concerns, or academic and personal difficulties



International Education at CCNY: Study Abroad & Exchanges



- The Office of Study Abroad & International Office offers a variety of opportunities throughout the world
 - More than 15 semester and year-long exchange programs
 - More than 20 intersession short-term programs
 - International service-learning and internship programs
 - Enriching environments of cross-cultural collaboration through the experiential learning model
 - And now participation through Global E3
- Staff is specialized in international health and safety issues, program development, and intercultural communication
- All students and faculty leaders attend pre-departure orientation sessions and reentry meeting

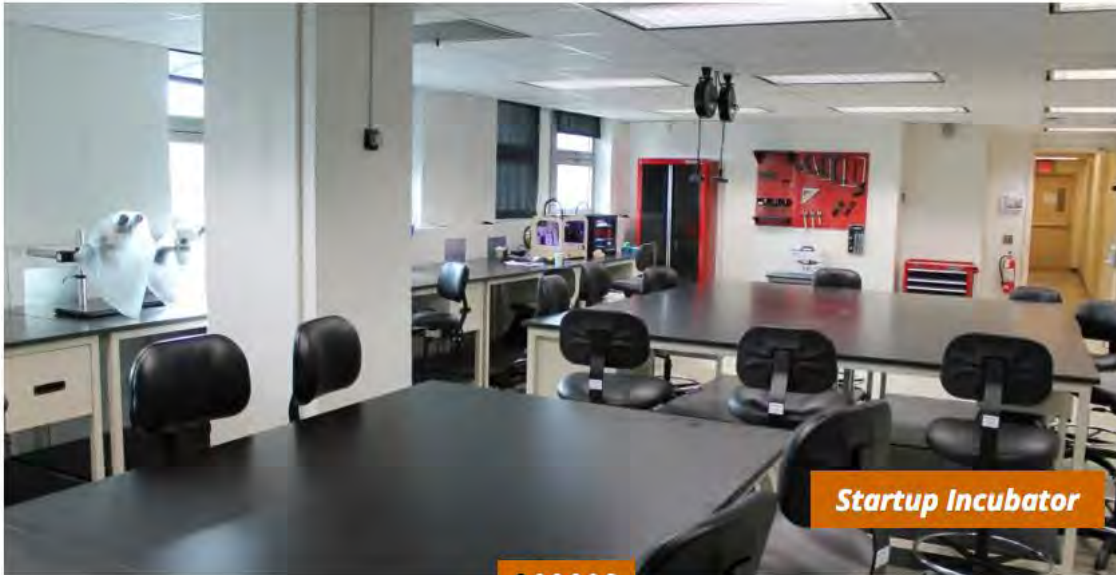

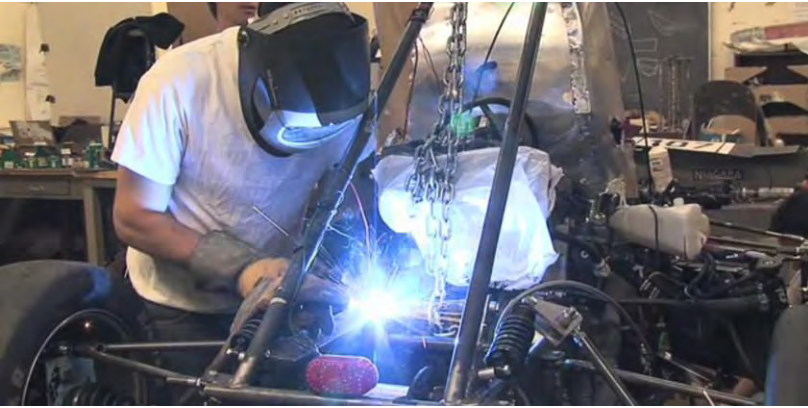
