

- Capital: Amsterdam

- 480 people / km² (USA: 34/ km²)
- 1/4 of the entire country is below sea level
- Among the tallest people in the world (~1,85 m)



fully accept examination results



• Minimum budget required by immigration service:

€ 795 / month ~ \$ 1030/month

- Initial settling-in expenses: € 1.500
- Costs: between € 850 € 1.100 / month
