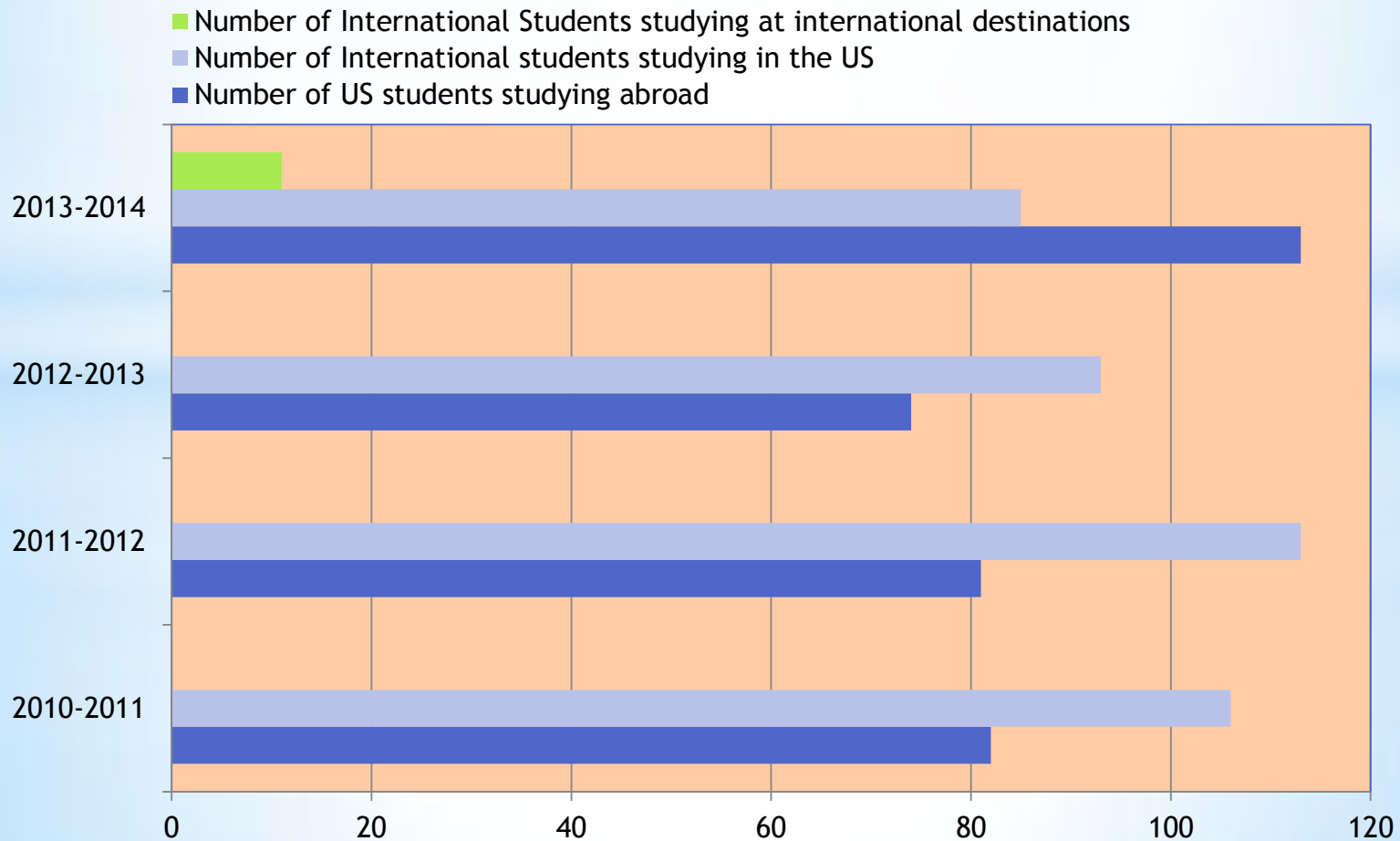

# Global E3 Student Placements

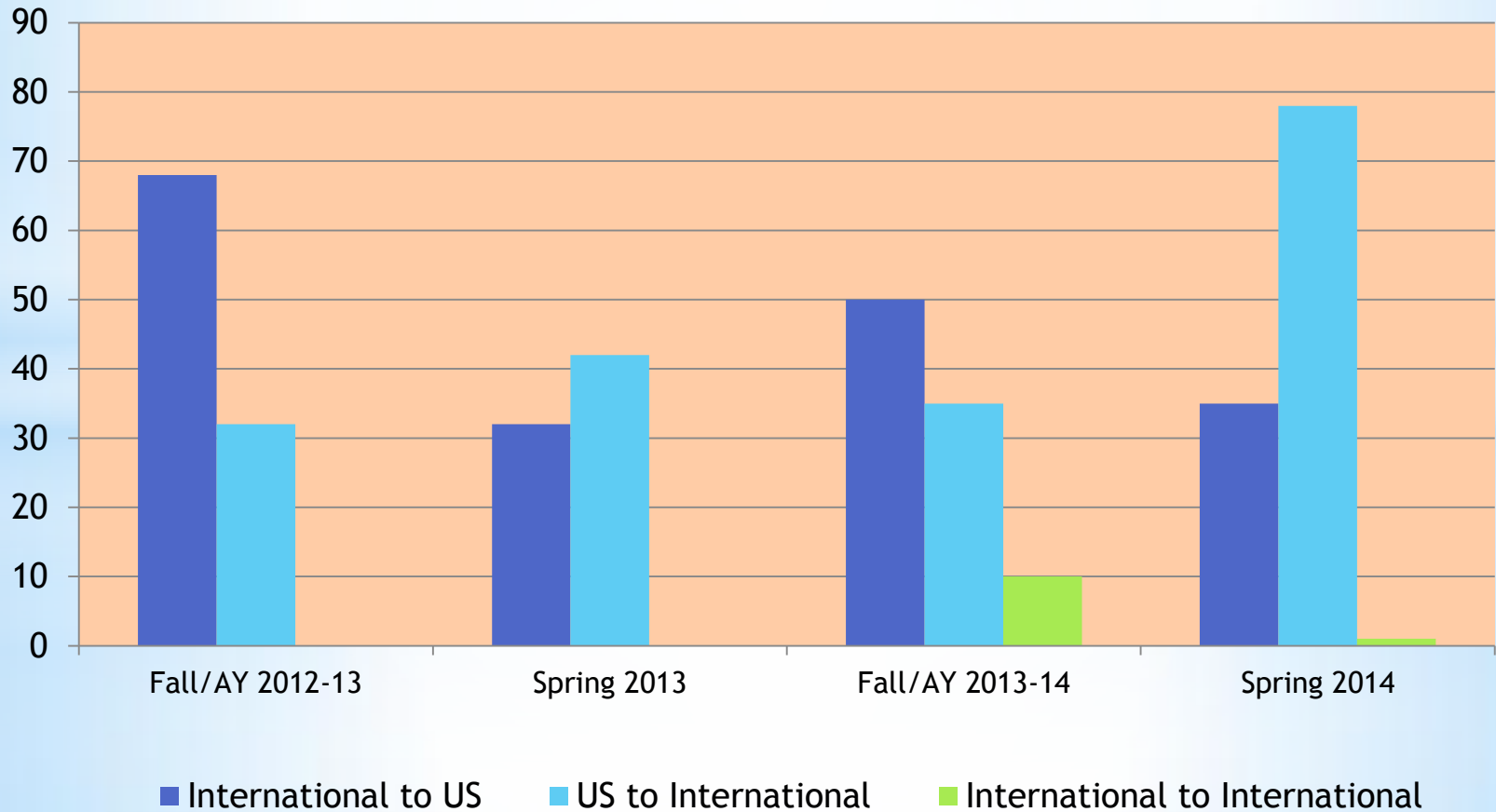
(last 4 years, 2011-14)

- International student participation consistent over past two years



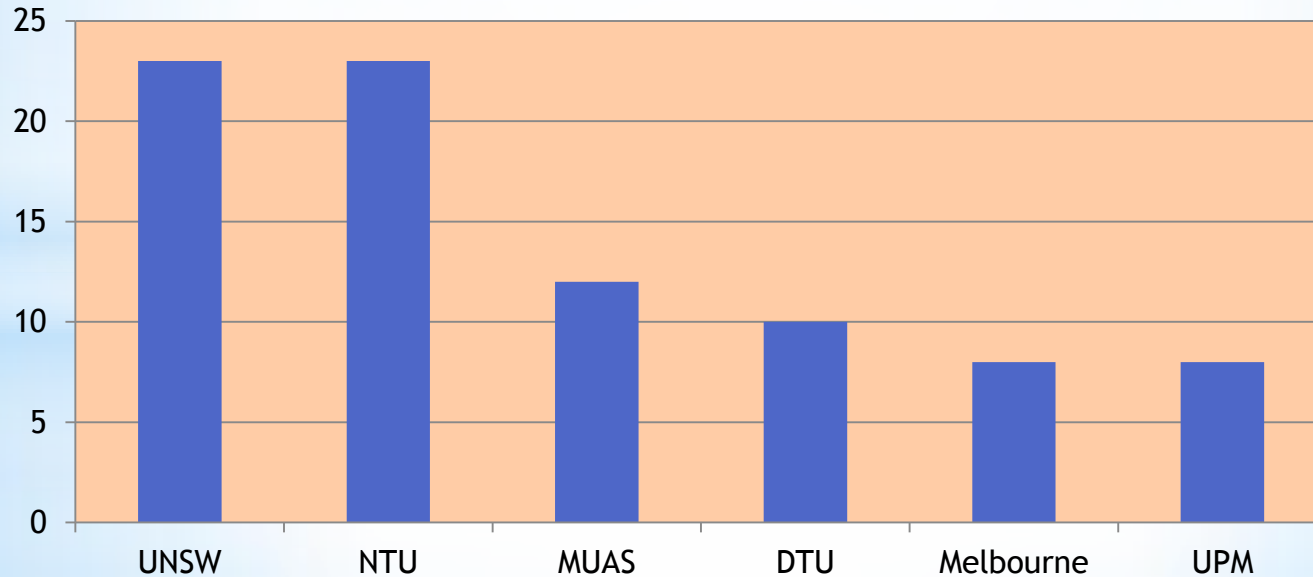
# Fall - Spring comparisons

- Spain's UPM is first time addition to the list of top requested institutions

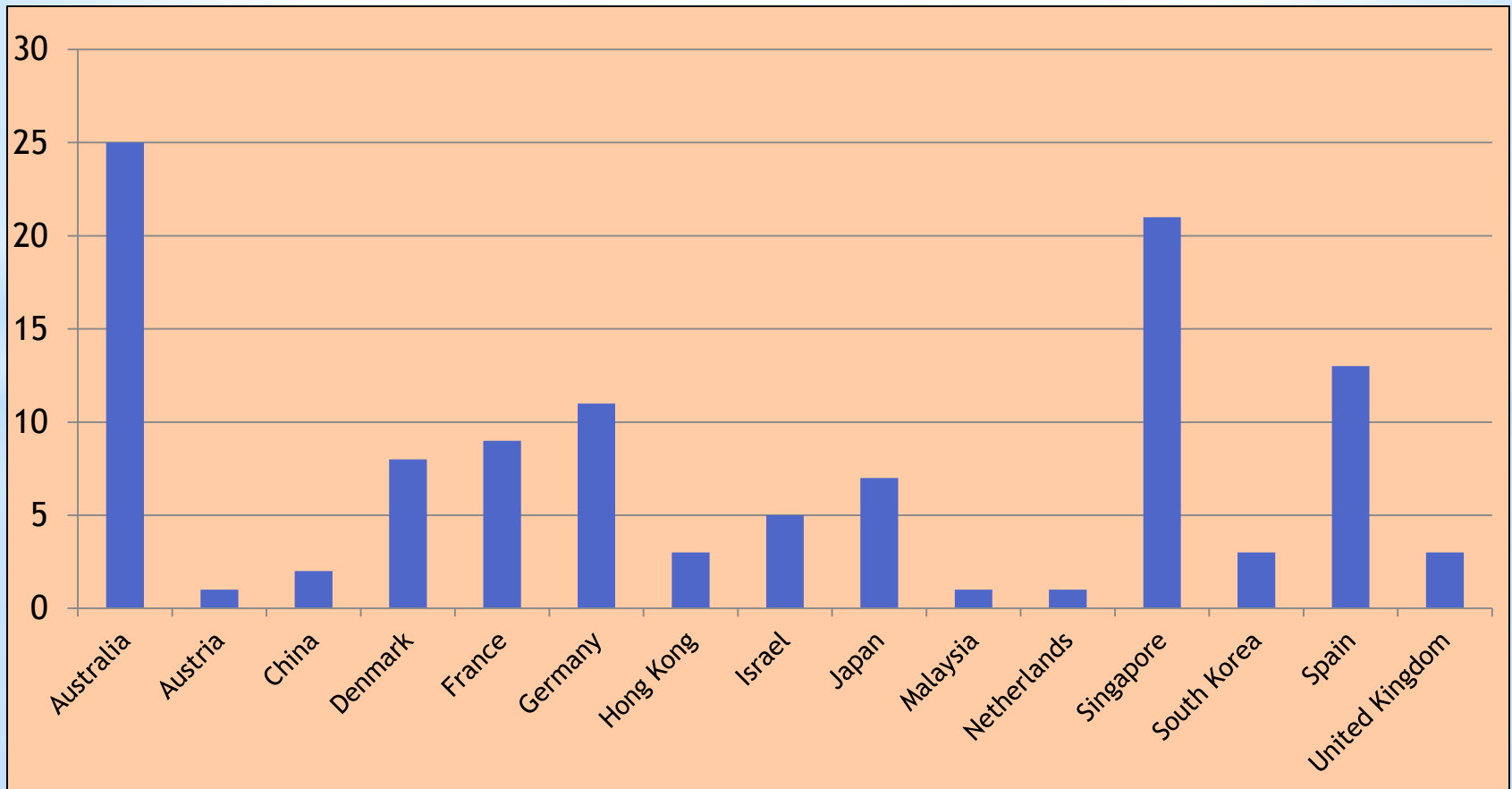

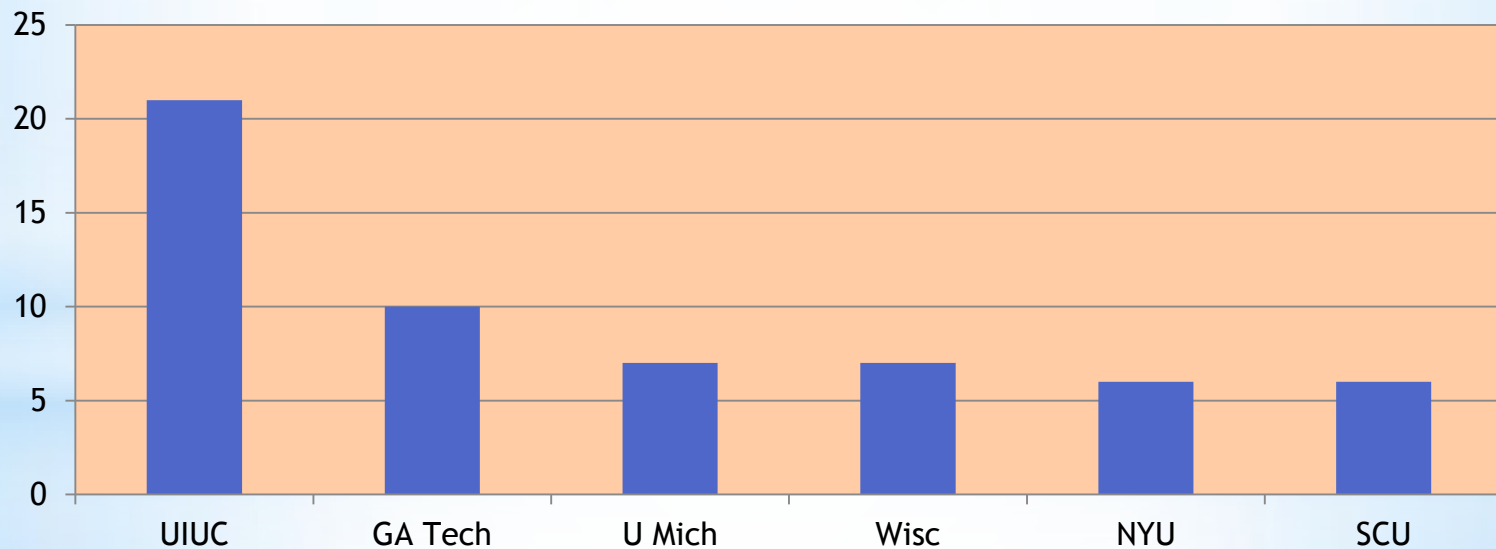
# US Student Destinations 2013 - 2014

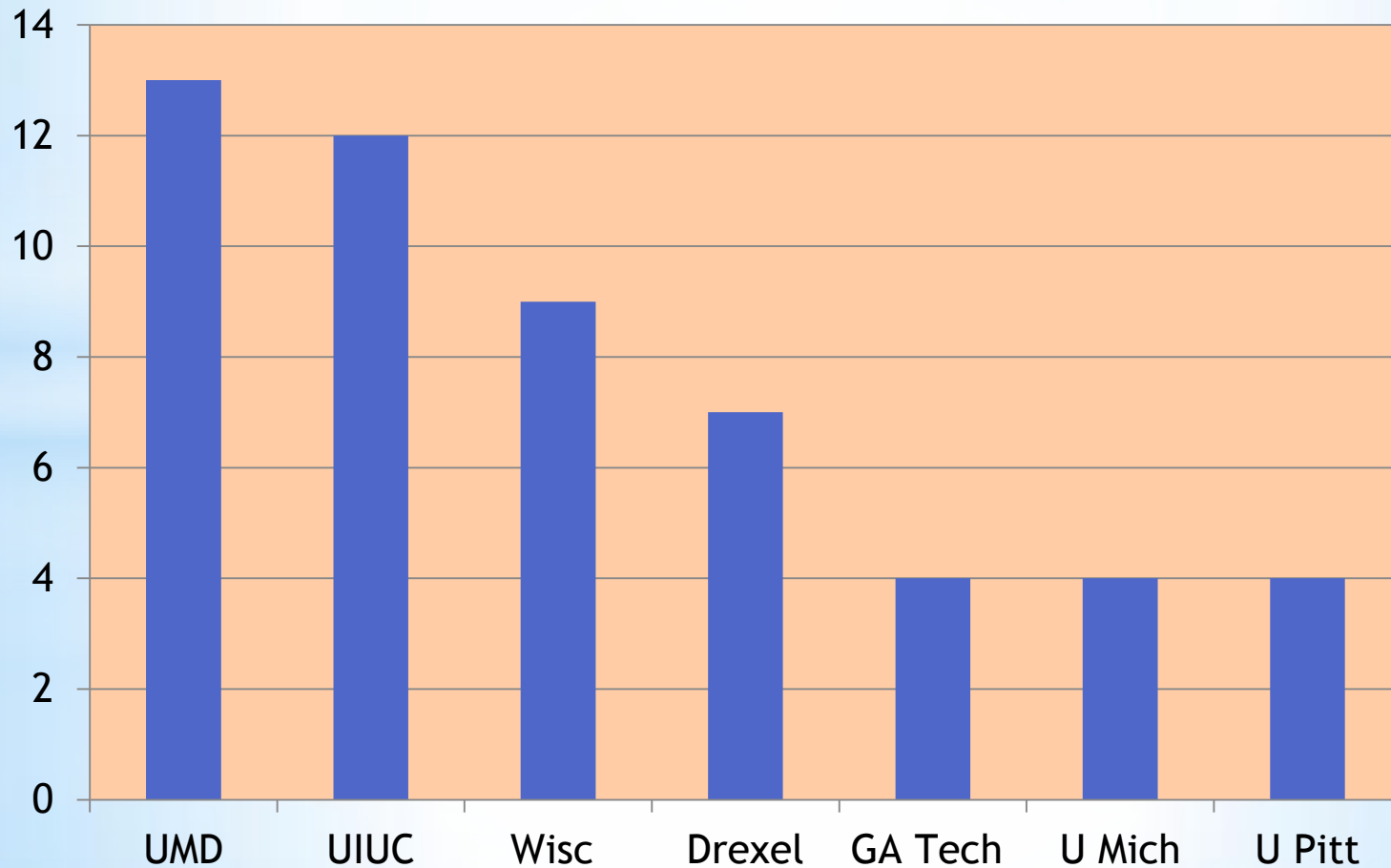

# Int'l Student Destinations 2013 - 2014 (top 7 universities)

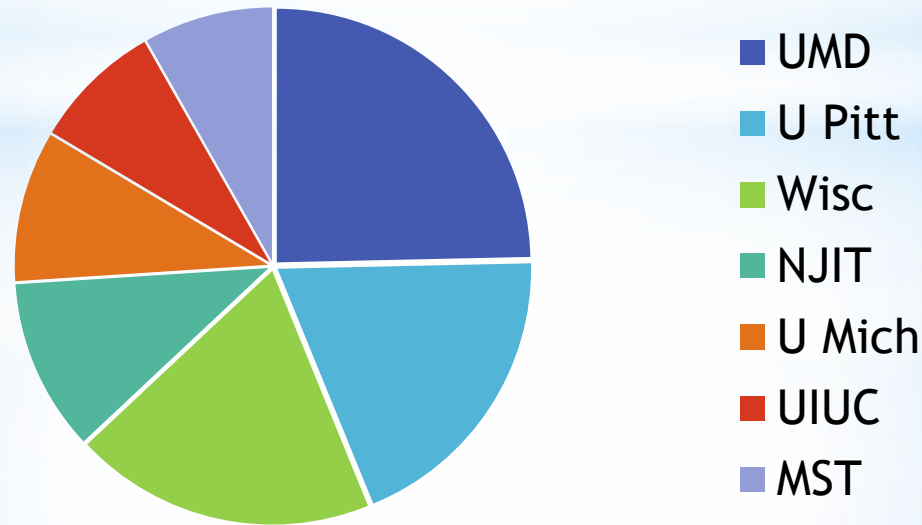


## Top 7 US Sending Institutions this year 2013 - 2014

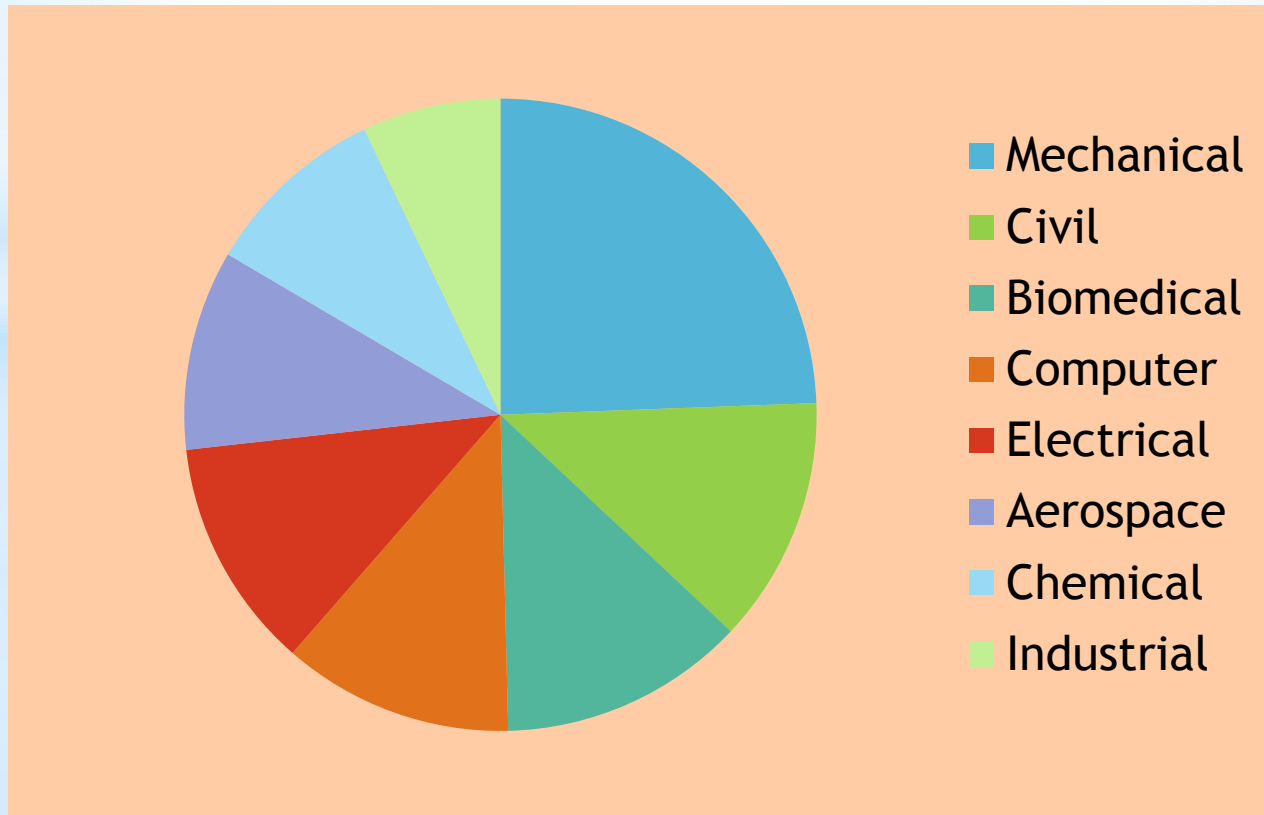
