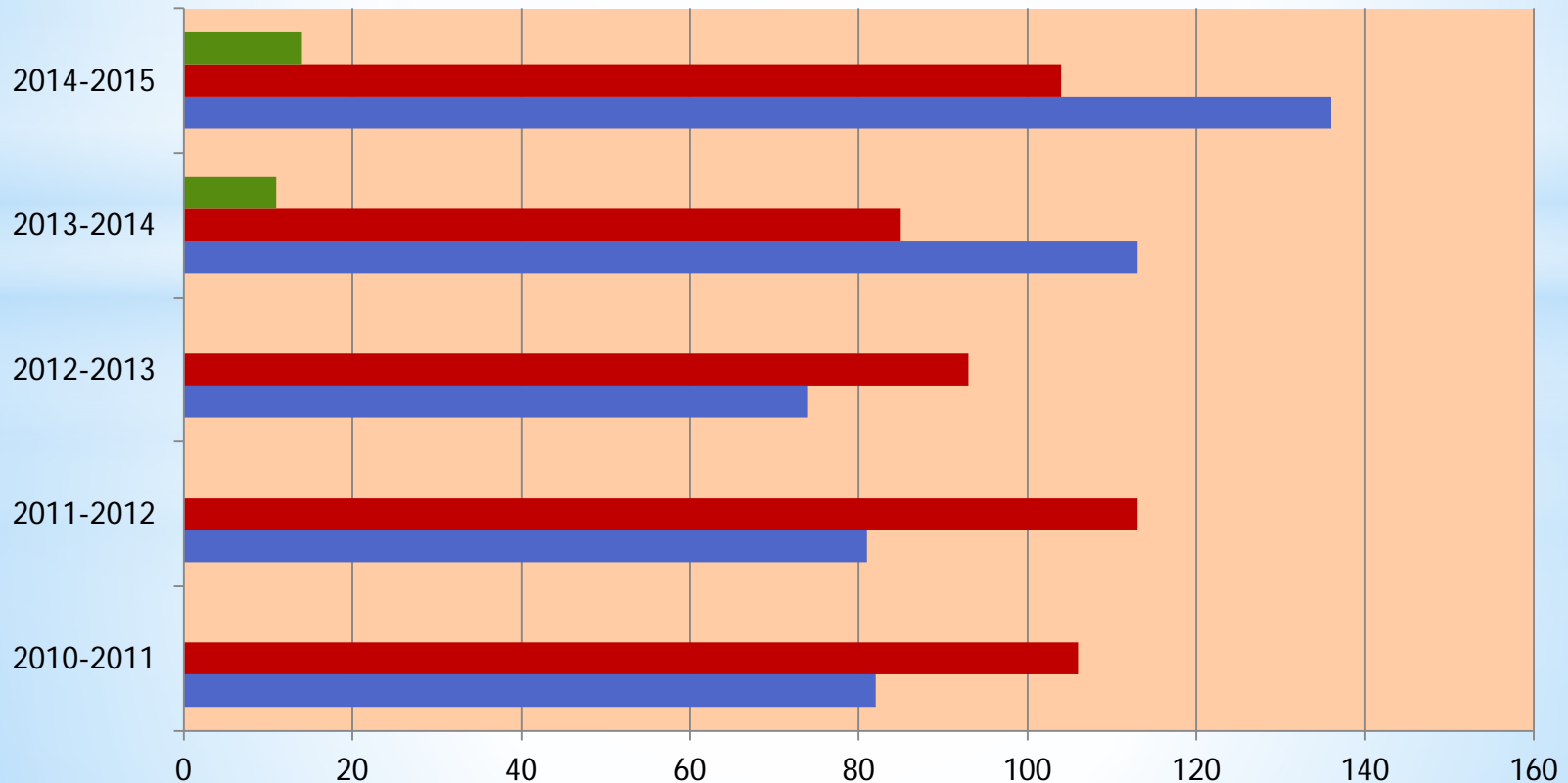


# Global E3 Student Placements

(last 5 years, 2011-15)

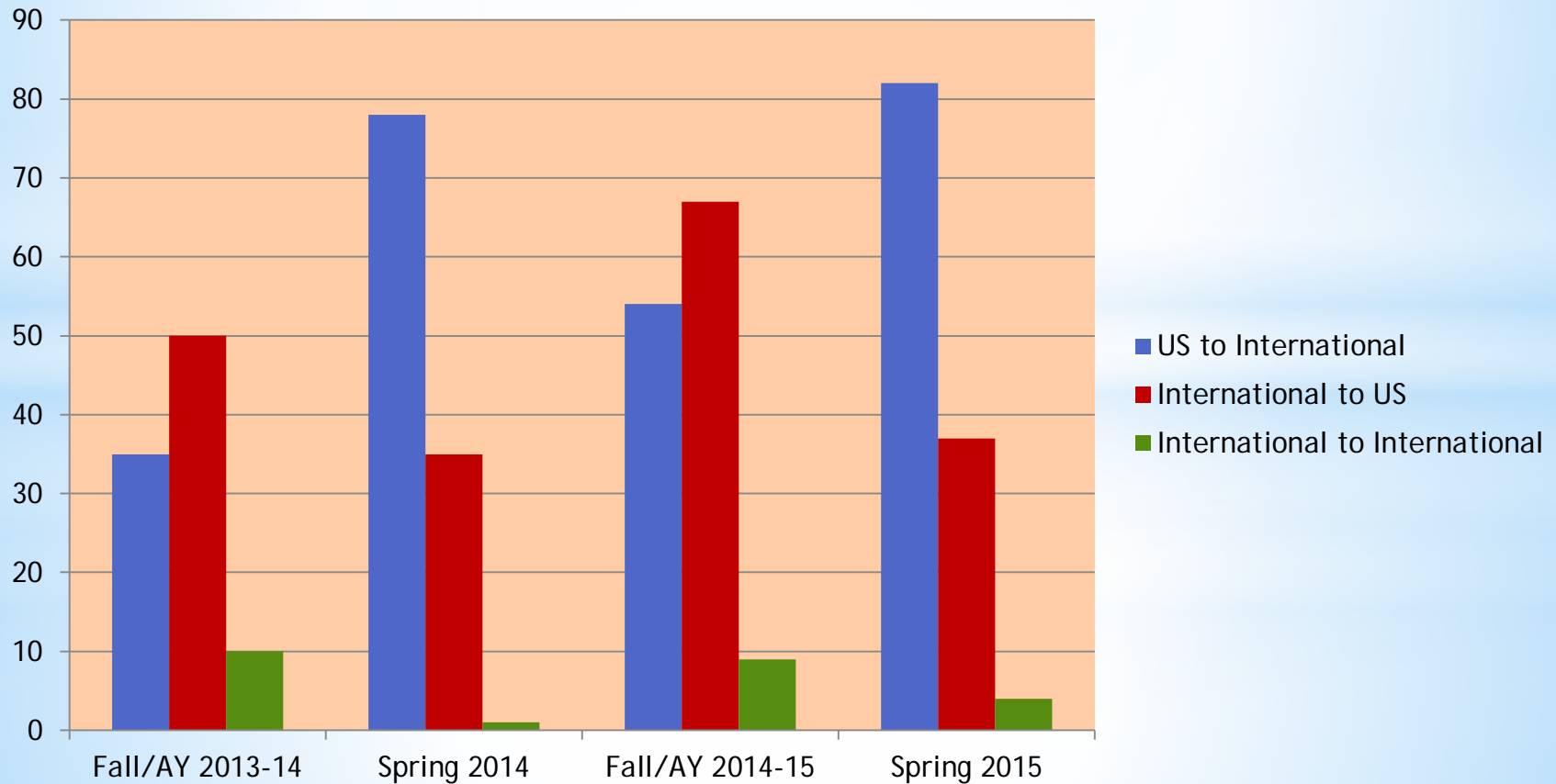
- In 2014-15, overall numbers up (254), as are US student numbers (136)

■ Number of US students Studying abroad



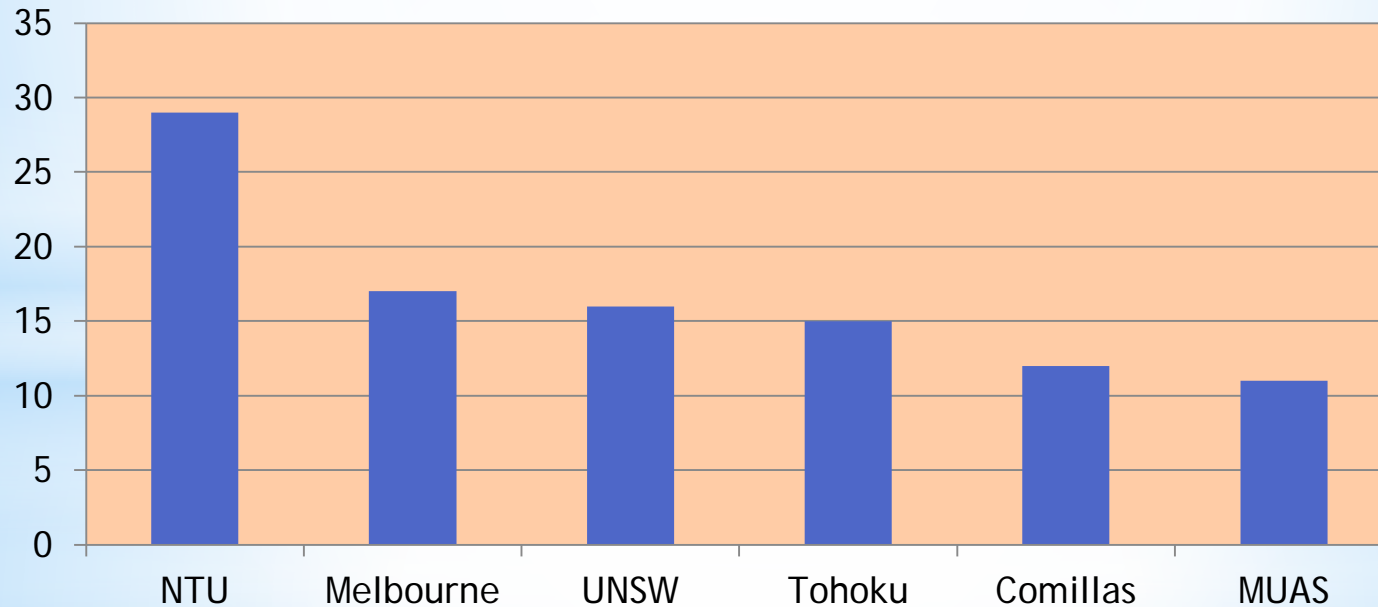
# Fall - Spring comparisons

- Both NTU and Tohoku are the only Global E3 universities in their respective countries

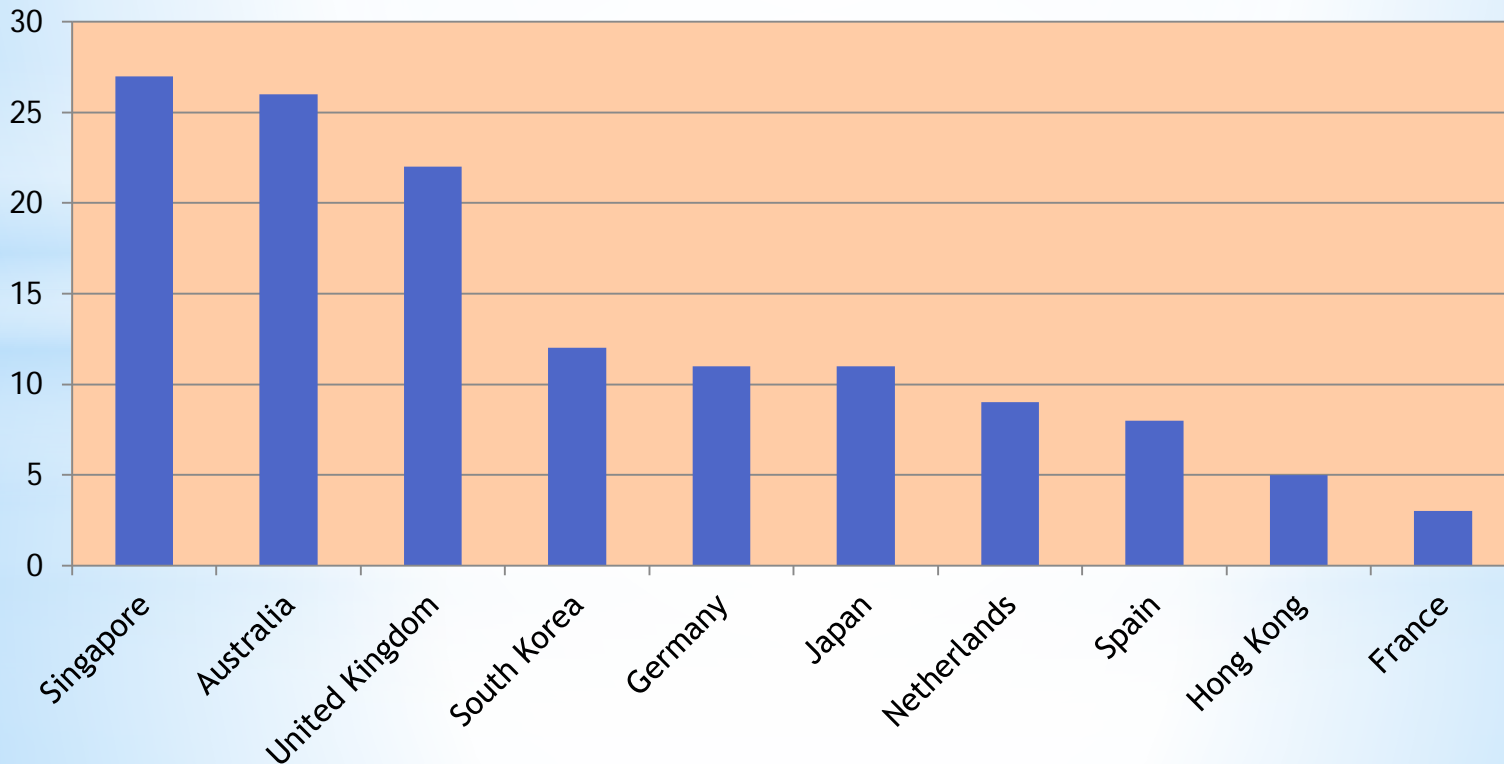

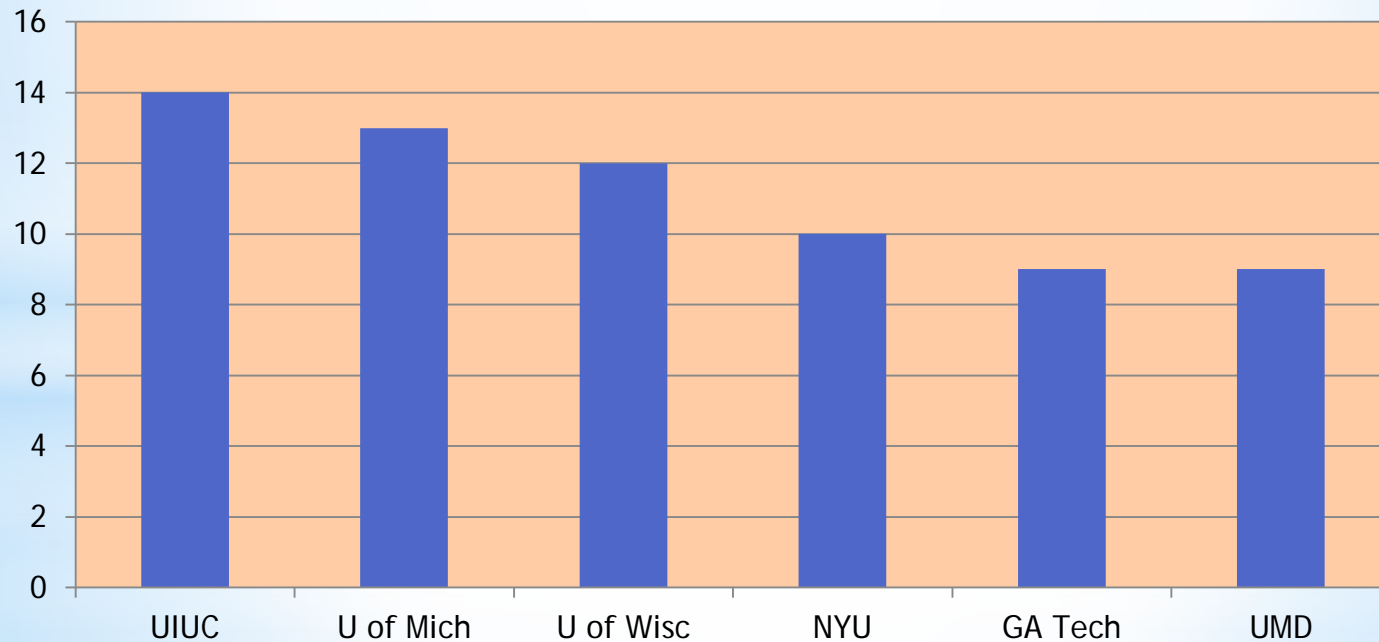
# US Student Destinations 2014 - 2015 (students placed)

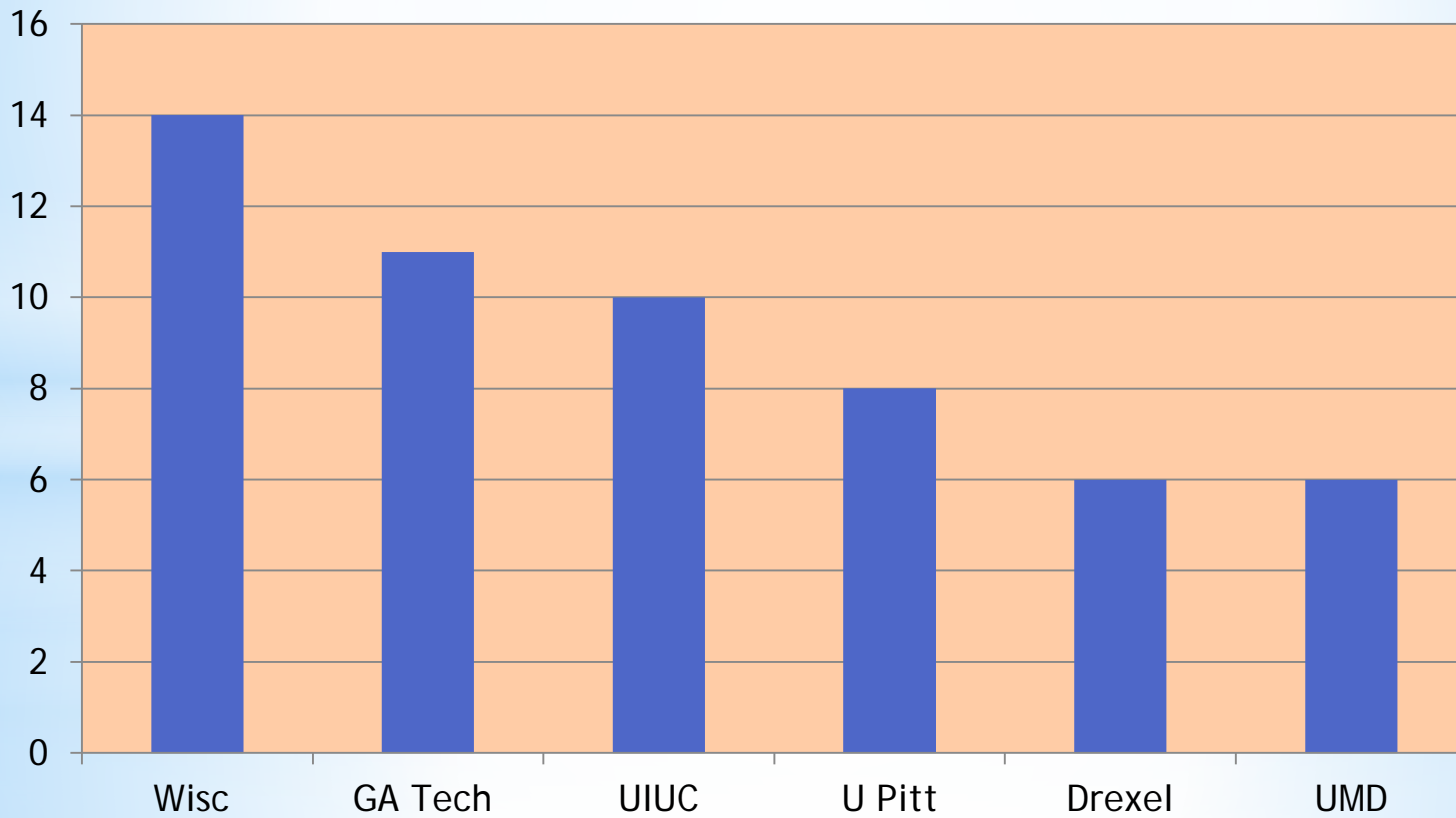

# Int'l Student Destinations 2014-15 (students placed)

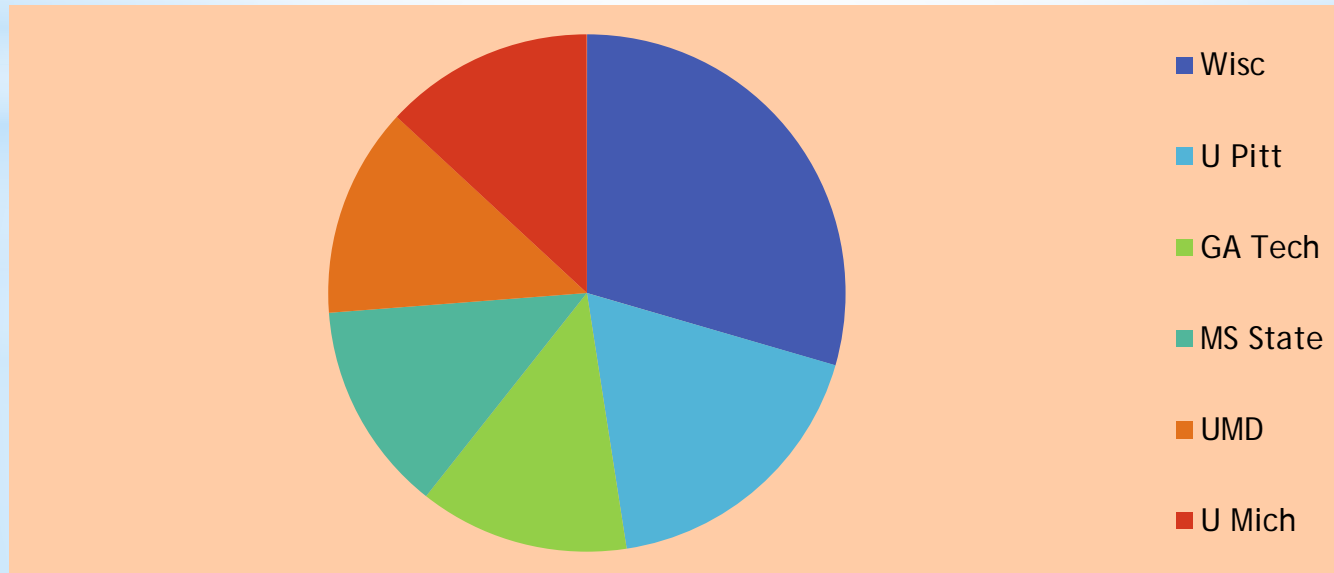


# Top 6 US Sending Institutions this year 2014 - 2015

*Georgia Tech - 8 students*

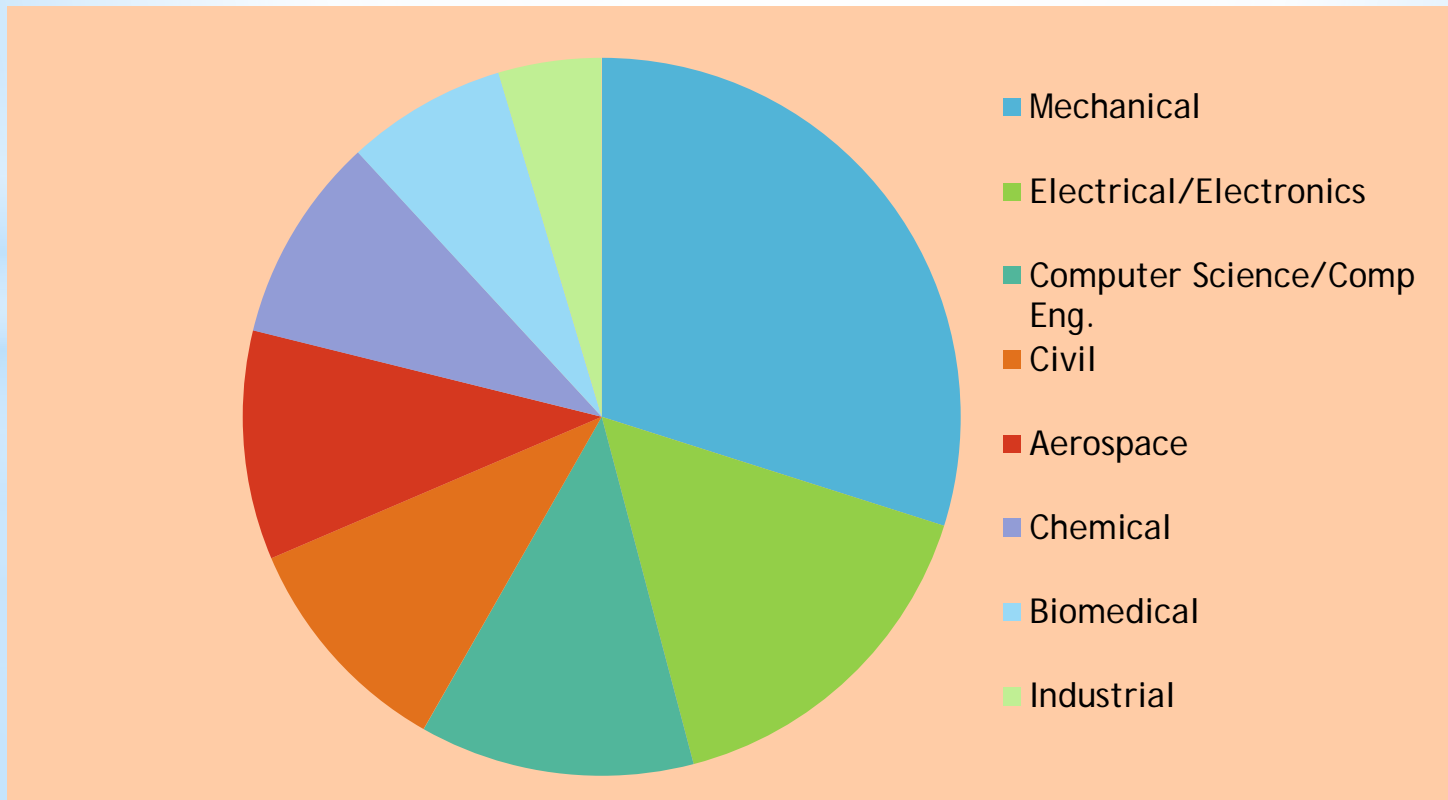
