
Global E3 Student Placements (last 5 years, 2011-15)

Number of International Students studying in the US


Number of US students Studying abroad



Fall – Spring comparisons


• Numbers steadily rising

Top 6 <u>Requested</u> International Institutions 2014 – 2015


- International destinations offering engineering courses in English continue to be top choices


US Student Destinations 2014 - 2015 (students placed)

• Singapore and Australia remain most popular with US students, followed by UK and South Korea replacing Spain and Germany, which were #3 and #4 in prior year.




Top 6 <u>Requested</u> US Institutions 2014 - 2015


Int'l Student Destinations 2014-15 (students placed)



Top 6 US Sending Institutions this year 2014 - 2015


 Numbers increasing because more schools are sending out, not only because each school is sending out more
