



Visa & Student Pass

- All international students are required to apply for student visa for the purpose of their stay in Malaysia and it is COMPULSORY to apply for a Visa of Approval (VDR) prior to arrival.
- UTM will help students to apply for the VDR prior to the student's arrival and the student visa after their arrival.
- Students are not allowed to enter Malaysia as a tourist if the intended stay is more than 90 days.

Insurance

All international students must keep a valid health insurance throughout their stay in Malaysia. Students must purchase Travel Insurance/Medical Insurance prior to their arrival and the insurance should cover their medical expenses in Malaysia.

Arrival And Orientation

Pre-Arrival

We will email the pre-arrival information together with the official offer letter which contains the information of the academic calendar, orientation, arrival tips, visa, accommodation and registration.

Arriving on Time

Students should arrive in UTM during the weekdays prior to the orientation session, the session is compulsory.

Orientation Session

The orientation session coordinates the first day on-campus experience for the student. It provides helpful information on enrolment requirements, visa information, settling into campus and answering to potential queries that might arise.
