- **Cost:** The LISS programme fee of **£3,145** includes tuition, accommodation, module field trips, weekend excursions, social programme, and sports centre membership. The cost of flights, insurance, visas and meals is not included.
 - For institutions that wish to send a group of 10 students or more, a 10% discount is available.
- **Scholarships:** Students with a GPA of 3.0 or above are eligible to apply for a Santander scholarship worth £500. You can apply by completing the scholarship section of the summer school application form.
